#### **KEYS & SECRETS ENHANCEMENTS**



We have removed the ability to view keys and secrets from the platform adding encryption at rest and in transit.

This change helps to ensure that unauthorised or malicious users are not able to access your keys or secrets.


#### **EXCLUDE EMAIL ATTACHMENTS**



We have had several requests from customers for the ability to restrict what attachments are included in the emails generated on form submission.

To cater for this we have added the Exclude Attachment feature, which allows you to pick and choose which attachment elements are included in the Emails.

- Exclude
  - Signatures
  - Files
  - Camera Images



#### **APPROVALS SAML**



One of the more highly requested features is the ability to authenticate approvers using a SAML provider.

We have released the first version of this integration now allowing you to create groups in the platform that can be mapped to your SAML user claims, removing the need to manage approvers in the platform.

- SAML Integration
  - Active Directory Authentication
  - Auth0 Authentication



#### **APPROVAL REMINDER**



Approvers can often miss new approval emails or lose track of their pending approvals. To assist with this we have added approval reminders.

Now you can ensure reminders are automatically sent to approvers if there are any approvals older than your configured threshold.

- Remind approvers of old approvals
- Configure reminders per form
- Configure custom reminder thresholds (e.g 1 day, 7 days, 14 days)



#### **GOOGLE ADDRESS SERVICES**



To accommodate customers who unable utilise the NSW Point and GeoScape address validation integration, we have integrated Google's address service.

This service enables form users to use an integrated address element instead of manually entering an address.

- Remove manual Address Inputs
- Automatically search on matching addresses



#### **OTHER UPDATES**





#### **Collapse Section**

Close section from the bottom, not just the top



#### **NSW Point**

Multiple environments & more conditional logic



#### **Location > Address**

Use Geoscape to get addresses from a device location



## Conditional Logic: Forms

Run conditional logic on nested form elements



#### **View Name**

View element names directly in the builder



#### **Email Branding**

Password reset emails include branding and sending address



#### Calculation Round

More rounding options for calculation elements



#### Security Enhancements

Multitude of support and infrastructure enhancements



#### **Accessibility**

Additional accessibility enhancements for screen readers.



## DEMONSTRATION PDF CONVERSION SERVICE

#### PDF CONVERSION SERVICE RECAP



The PDF Conversion has had a number of enhancements including capturing informational content and more recently creation checkbox elements as part of the conversion process.

Use the PDF Conversion feature to reduce the amount of time required to build out OneBlink forms from existing PDF based processes.

- Input Element (text, phone numbers, email addresses)
- Informational Element (headings, information)
- Signature elements
- Checkboxes (Yes, No, NA options)
